#### What Should You NOT Pack?



Let's discuss what to avoid bringing on your vacation.

There are some more obvious items, such as drugs and weapons. However, there are some items that may slip your mind that are NOT allowed on cruises.

- > Extension cords (surge protected or not)
  - > Candles or other fire hazards
    - > Pets
    - > CBD products
    - > Irons & Steamers
- > Knives, or Scissors with blades longer than 4 inches
  - > Hoverboards
- > Kitchen appliances such as coffee makers, hot plates, or crock pots

This list is not exhaustive, and can slightly differ from cruise line to cruise line. Make sure to read the list of prohibited and allowed items with the cruise line you are traveling with to make sure you are following the rules!
