- Medications
- Travel insurance

Cruise-Specific Items:

- Magnetic hooks for cabin walls
- Packing cubes for organization
- Formalwear for dinner (if applicable)
- Luggage tags for checked baggage

Avoid:

- Irons or surge protectors (cruise lines often prohibit these items)
 - Cruise lines often have a list that you can check for prohibited items!
- Overpacking—cabin space is limited!

1. **Embarkation Day:** Arrive on time for your check-in, explore the ship, and attend the mandatory muster drill to ensure your safety.
2. **Utilize the Daily Planner or App:** Keep track of activities and events happening onboard to maximize your cruise experience.
3. **Don't Miss Onboard Highlights:** Enjoy specialty dining, attend spectacular shows, and relax!

Budget Tips for First-Time Cruisers

1. **Be Aware of Hidden Costs:** Gratuities, specialty dining, and excursions can add up. Factor these into your budget. It is important to decide on drinks packages/dining packages based on how often you believe you will use them. For example, if you do not drink specialty drinks often, it may be more cost-effective to pay as you go.

Cruise Etiquette for Newbies

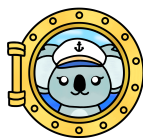
1. **Do:** Be courteous to fellow passengers and crew. Kindness goes a long way onboard.
